		CPCA is requested to provide funding to Peterborough City Council to enable refresh of promotional materials for Inward Investment activity to target and attract Inward Investors and Central UK Government relocations to the Greater Peterborough sub-economy area. The total value of this project work is £29,739 and the contribution being sought from CPCA



towards the project contract is: £15,239 (52%). Peterborough CC will be funding the balance of £14,500 (48%).

PCC will procurement and sub-contracted the elements of delivery.
